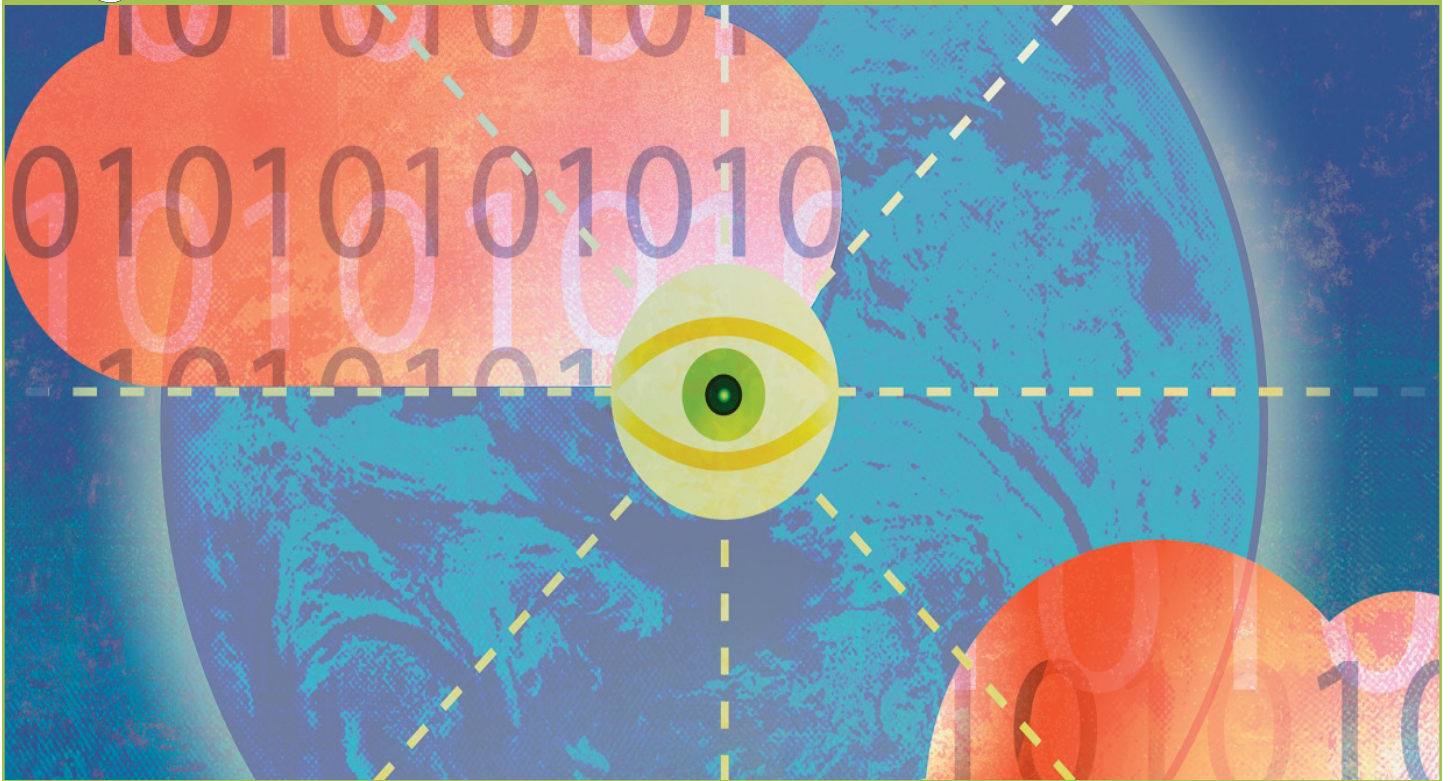

Algorithms are a series of step-by-step instructions in a procedure that finishes and which is shown to work in all cases.
